SchoolTV offers clear, expert-led guidance on a wide range of topics affecting young people today and serves as a trusted first point of reference for staff. By strengthening mental health literacy, it supports you to recognise early signs of concern and confidently direct families to consistent, evidence-informed support, enabling early intervention without adding to your workload.

Each topic features interviews with leading specialists, along with links to carefully curated resources from trusted organisations. Content is easy to access, can be viewed privately and supports understanding, confidence and constructive conversations with students and their families. **Written content** can be translated into more than **60 languages**, and **video interviews** are available in **Russian, French, Spanish, Hindi, Chinese and Arabic**, with additional languages planned for release soon.

Throughout the year, SchoolTV also offers **free webinars** featuring leading experts, providing practical, evidence-informed guidance that supports professional practice and family engagement around key mental health and wellbeing topics.

Staff are encouraged to refer families to SchoolTV and to sign up to **Get Alerts** using the button within any SchoolTV topic. This ensures you are notified when new topics are released and helps you stay informed about emerging issues, digital trends and seasonal topics.
